

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE TO RATIFY THE DETERMINATION OF THE ADMINISTRATION ON THE 2022/2023 PROPERTY, CASUALTY AND LIABILITY INSURANCE RENEWAL WITH TRAVELERS INSURANCE FOR THE SUM OF \$291,138.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton's insurance broker, Fedeli Insurance, had solicited proposals for property, casualty and liability insurance and recommended the proposal of Travelers Insurance Company; and

WHEREAS: The Administration has secured this proposal for the protection of the city's assets; and

WHEREAS: Council does hereby ratify and adopt the proposal for property, casualty and liability insurance submitted by Travelers Insurance for the quoted sum of \$291,138.00 for 2022/2023; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to affirm and record this ratification.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Council of the City of North Royalton ratifies the selection of Travelers Insurance's proposal for 2022/2023 renewal of Property, Casualty and Liability Insurance for the sum of \$291,138.00.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Travelers Insurance.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason to protect the city's assets.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
