AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 22-76 AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) JOHN DEERE GATOR UTILITY VEHICLE FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON WASTEWATER DEPARTMENT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$11,262.73, VENDOR AG-PRO COMPANIES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council has authorized the purchase of one (1) utility vehicle for the North Royalton Wastewater Department; and

WHEREAS: Ordinance 22-76 authorized the purchase of one (1) utility vehicle for an amount not to exceed \$11,262.73; and

WHEREAS: Ordinance 22-76 refers to the vendor as Ag-Pro Companies, not Deere & Company; and

WHEREAS: In order to ensure correct documentation for payment, it is necessary to amend Ordinance 22-76 to refer to the vendor as Deere & Company, not Ag-Pro Companies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby amends Ordinance 22-76 to replace all references to vendor "Ag-Pro Companies" to "Deere & Company".

Section 2. Ordinance 22-76 is hereby amended as provided for herein and all other provisions of Ordinance 22-76 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted Ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to amend Ordinance 22-76 to refer to the vendor as Deere & Company rather than Ag-Pro Companies to ensure correct documentation for payment.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
