AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF NORTH ROYALTON COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM (CERT) VOLUNTEER LIABILITY INSURANCE WITH PROVIDENT AGENCY, INC, FOR THE SUM OF \$1890.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The North Royalton Community Response Team (CERT) requires annual liability insurance; and

WHEREAS: In years past, CERT has held fundraisers to obtain monies to pay for their annual liability insurance; and

WHEREAS: Due to COVID 19, CERT has been unable to hold fundraisers, thus requiring the City to purchase liability insurance; and

WHEREAS: Council authorizes the purchase of liability insurance for CERT in the amount of \$1890.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the purchase of liability insurance for CERT in the amount of \$1890.00 and as further described on Exhibit A attached hereto.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Provident Agency, Inc.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason to authorize the purchase of liability insurance for CERT.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
