AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 12-149 TO RECLASSIFY AN ADVANCE OF \$30,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL FUND (#101) TO YORK ROAD SEWER IMPROVEMENT FUND (#448) AS A TRANSFER THEREOF IN ACCORD WITH THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE AUDITOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The 2021 audit revealed that in 2012 an Advance of funds was made from the General Fund to the York Road Sewer Improvement Fund in the sum of \$30,000.00 which is more properly identified as a Transfer thereof, and

WHEREAS: The auditor has recommended that Council revisit that action and that it be reclassified as a Transfer of those funds, and

WHEREAS: In keeping with best practices and the city's desire to conform to the highest standards of municipal accounting the Finance Director has requested that Council approve this amendment, and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Ordinance 12-149 is amended to reflect that the movement of \$30,000.00 from the General Fund to the York Road Sewer Improvement Fund is hereby reclassified as a Transfer of those funds.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to conform to the highest standards of municipal accounting.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of a majority of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
