A RESOLUTION DONATING FOUR (4) FORMER MAYOR PORTRAITS
TO THE NORTH ROYALTON HISTORICAL SOCIETY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City is in possession of four (4) former North Royalton Mayor portraits; and

WHEREAS: The North Royalton Historical Society would like to acquire and display these at the James Buckingham Museum for visitors to view and help tell the story of the history of North Royalton city government; and

WHEREAS: Council believes it is in the best interest of the City to donate the four (4) former North Royalton Mayor portraits to the North Royalton Historical Society due to their historic and educational value; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this donation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Council hereby approves the donation of four (4) former North Royalton Mayor portraits to the North Royalton Historical Society.

Section 2. The North Royalton Historical Society will provide a receipt to the city that will identify date of receipt of the portraits.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to donate the four (4) former North Royalton Mayor portraits to the North Royalton Historical Society due to their historic nature and need for preservation.

THEREFORE, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
