

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 23-108

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A TWO YEAR CONTRACT WITH THE GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY PROVIDING HEALTH SERVICES FOR YEARS 2024 AND 2025 FOR THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton desires to enter into a contract for public health services with the General Health District of Cuyahoga County for years 2024 and 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor of the City of North Royalton is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a two year contract, in substantially the same form as a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, with the General Health District of Cuyahoga County providing health services to the people of the City of North Royalton for years 2024 and 2025.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$227,085.00 for 2024, same to be charged to the General Fund but actually to be deducted by the County Auditor from the regular tax settlement for the City of North Royalton for the year 2024 in equal semi-annual installments of \$113,542.50.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$250,576.00 for 2025, same to be charged to the General Fund but actually to be deducted by the County Auditor from the regular tax settlement for the City of North Royalton for the year 2025 in equal semi-annual installments of \$125,288.00.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that said contract must be properly executed and returned prior to its effective date of January 1, 2024.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
