

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 23-112

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 23-93 FIXING THE CHARGES FOR BOTH PER DIEM AND ANNUAL RENTAL TO BE PAID FOR THE LEASE OF JAIL CELL BED(S) AT THE NORTH ROYALTON JAIL FOR 2024, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO CONCLUDE AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENTS AND/OR LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES FOR JAIL CELL BED(S) RENTALS, BY INCLUDING AN ADDITIONAL PER JAIL CELL BED RATE FOR ANNUAL LEASES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Ordinance 23-93 authorized the Mayor to conclude agreements with other municipal governments and/or law enforcement agencies for jail cell bed rentals of an annual rate of Seventy Three Thousand Dollars (\$73,000.00) per jail cell bed and that the per diem rate be fixed at Two Hundred and Thirty Dollars (\$230.00) per jail cell bed for 2024; and

WHEREAS: Due to a scrivener's error, it is therefore necessary to amend Ordinance 23-93 to include an additional per jail cell bed rate for annual leases in the amount of \$200.00; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to amend Ordinance 23-93 to include an additional per jail cell bed rate for annual leases in the 2024 agreements with other municipal governments and/or law enforcement agencies for jail cell bed(s) rentals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Ordinance 23-93 is hereby amended to include an additional per jail cell bed rate for annual leases in the amount of \$200.00 in the 2024 agreements with other municipal governments and/or law enforcement agencies for jail cell bed(s) rentals.

Section 2. Ordinance 23-93 is hereby amended as provided for herein and all other provisions of Ordinance 23-93 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to amend Ordinance 23-93 amended to include an additional per jail cell bed rate for annual leases.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
