AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 22-50 AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT FOR DONATIONS/FUNDS FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON CITY SPONSORED EVENTS BY SPECIFYING TWO ADDITIONAL CITY SPONSORED EVENTS, THE SOLAR ECLIPSE BASH, AND THE TOUCH-A-TRUCK POLICE NIGHT OUT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton sponsors certain city events; and

WHEREAS: Council has provided funds for the support of those events; and

WHEREAS: Council approved Ordinance 22-50 authorizing the receipt for donations/funds for the North Royalton city sponsored events; and

WHEREAS: It is necessary to amend Ordinance 22-50 by specifying an additional city sponsored events known as The Solar Eclipse Bash; and

WHEREAS: It is necessary to amend Ordinance 22-50 by specifying an additional city sponsored events known as Touch-a-Truck Police Night Out; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby amends Ordinance 22-50 to receive any and all donations to the specific city sponsored events known as: North Royalton Easter Parade, Parkapalooza, Movie Nights, Fishing Derby, Car Show, Harvest Fest, Halloween Madness, Holiday Lighting and Community Festival fireworks display, Solar Eclipse Bash, Touch-a-Truck Police Night Out, and directs the Mayor to adopt such reasonable restrictions for the use of those funds as may be reasonable and/or required by law.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is necessary to amend Ordinance 22-50 to specify an additional city sponsored event to authorize receipt of these donations/funds.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
