

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 24-30

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) FORD F600 DUMP BODY AND SNOW PLOW EQUIPMENT FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON SERVICE DEPARTMENT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$59,012.92, FROM CONCORD ROAD EQUIPMENT, MFG, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council has authorized the purchase of one (1) motor vehicle and equipment package for the North Royalton Service Department; and

WHEREAS: The city is purchasing this vehicle and equipment through Concord Road Equipment, MFG, which meets or exceeds the specifications of the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services, as required by House Bill 204; and

WHEREAS: It is necessary to provide for the funding of said purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$59,012.92 for the purchase of one (1) Ford F600 Dump Body and Snow Plow Equipment Package for the North Royalton Service Department from Concord Road Equipment, MFG, 8200 Tyler Blvd. Suite H, Mentor, Ohio 44060, and as further described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. This purchase meets or exceeds the specifications of the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services, as required by House Bill 204.

Section 3. The Director of Public Service and Properties is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Concord Road Equipment, MFG.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the purchase of this vehicle and equipment for the North Royalton Service Department for the proper and immediate performance of departmental duties.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
