ORDINANCE NO. 24-31

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2024 CHEVROLET EQUINOX FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON MAYOR'S OFFICE FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$27,185.65, FROM TIM LALLY CHEVROLET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The office of the Mayor has a need for a new vehicle and has selected a 2024 Chevrolet Equinox; and

WHEREAS: The proposal is to purchase this vehicle through Tim Lally Chevrolet as identified in the exhibit attached; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to approve the funding for said purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$27,185.65 for the purchase of one (1) 2024 Chevrolet Equinox for the North Royalton Mayor's Office from Tim Lally Chevrolet, 24999 Miles Rd, Warrensville Heights, OH 44128, and as further described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The Mayor's Office is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Tim Lally Chevrolet.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the purchase of this vehicle and equipment for the North Royalton Service Department for the proper and immediate performance of departmental duties.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
