AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING HELEN DUNLAP AS CLERK OF COUNCIL FOR THE
CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 20, 2024,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The position of Clerk of Council is an appointive position; and

WHEREAS: The President of Council has chosen to appoint Helen Dunlap to this position, effective February 20, 2024; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON,
COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby confirms Helen Dunlap as Clerk of Council, effective February 20, 2024.


Section 2. Said appointment shall continue until such time as a successor has been appointed and confirmed.

Section 3. Compensation and benefits for the Clerk of Council shall be in accord with the ordinances governing full time non-union employees except that Ms. Dunlap will be entitled to the following paid vacation schedule: effective, February 20, 2024 – two (2) weeks paid vacation, effective January 1, 2025 – three (3) weeks paid vacation, effective January 1, 2026 – four (4) weeks paid vacation, and effective January 1, 2027 – five (5) weeks paid vacation; thereafter her vacation benefit shall follow the full-time non union benefit ordinance.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to appoint a new Clerk of Council to fill the vacancy.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
