ORDINANCE NO. 24-46

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) VENTRAC 4520Y TRACTOR FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON WASTEWATER DEPARTMENT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$32,474.50, FROM MAST-LEPLEY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council has authorized the purchase of one (1) Ventrac 4520Y tractor and accessory package for the North Royalton Wastewater Department; and

WHEREAS: The Wastewater Department sought proposals for the purchase of one (1) Ventrac 4520Y tractor and accessory package; and

WHEREAS: It has been determined that the proposal submitted by Mast-Lepley is the lowest and best proposal; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to accept this proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$32,474.50 for the purchase of one (1) Ventrac 4520Y tractor and accessory package for the North Royalton Wastewater Department from Mast-Lepley, 7787 East Lincoln Way, Apple Creek, Ohio 44606, as the lowest and best proposal.

Section 2. The Director of Wastewater is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Mast-Lepley.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.


Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the purchase of this vehicle and equipment for the North Royalton Service Department for the proper and immediate performance of departmental duties.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
