Council

Paul Marnecheck – 170 deer were harvested from bow program in 2017, which is 20 more than 2016. Animal control collected over 500 deer carcasses from disease or hit by cars. 91 permits were issued in 2017 versus 81 in 2016. The city has been able to crack seal all county roads in during the past 3 years.

Mayor Robert Stefanik (Larry Antoskiewicz) – The schools are fixing and resurfacing tennis and basketball courts. Mr. Antoskiewicz reminded everyone about bicentennial 2-week event early August 2018.

NORTH ROYALTON RECOGNIZED CLUBS:

Baseball (NRBB): Craig Barbeck – Registration for rec opened this month. NRBB wants to partner with the Indians for clinics and/or games. They gave Mr. Swim a check to purchase the field groomer. NRBB will have a Superbowl squares pool fundraiser this year. They are changing the locks on York Road field facilities. There is still no internet at York yet. Mr. Barbeck asked who purchased the Heart defibrillators (AED). Mr. Swim said each organization bought their own since the city buildings would be closed during game and practice times for baseball or soccer. Mr. Barbeck said they would need 5 defibrillators to cover the entire York Road complex. Dr. Kelly talked about an external storage box with an alarm that is used at the stadium. NRBB is trying to network with young professional groups to recruit trustees and coaches for teams. They want trustees to come to 10-12 meetings a year. About 30 hours during season. They are inviting Kona Ice to come to York fields this year for the Bear Bash and Bear Ball. Kona Ice will give 20% back to the community.

Soccer (NRSC): Vincent Weimer - NRSC approved the budget for new year. Rec and Travel registrations will open in the spring. They had a shortcoming last year and may adjust registration costs this year. They finalized sexual molestation policy. It will be place for upcoming season.

Basketball: Tom Grassi - In the last week of season. The Lake Erie tournament starts next week. 3rd and 4th grade team won league. Girls are doing well

North Royalton Community Garden (NRCG): Dejana Cinquepalmi - The first meeting is scheduled on 2/19 form/fee day, plots assigned. NRCG will be replacing the boards on 10-12 plots with money from Cargill. They have an Eagle scout that wants to expand garden toward state road by 25x75. The area will need to be leveled.

NR Youth Football: Not Present, No Report

YMCA: Brandon Bussey - Jr Cavs started their first games a few weeks ago. There are over 300 kids in program. There is 1 day left to get the lower joiner fee. The YMCA will try volleyball again. Volleyball was not successful the last time they tried. They will be doing t-ball for 3-4 yr olds again. The Y wants to use the area on north side of driveway off state road. They are asking the community for ideas.
