## REPORTS

### Recreation Department

**Jason Swim** – Mr. Swim has met with each organization about the city requirements. Please see the document attached to minutes for a complete list of the requirements. The wi-fi at York is working, but they are having antenna issues communicating with NRBB building.

### Council

**Paul Marnecheck** – The City Green design is nearly complete. It will go out to bid soon. They are going to preserve the historical markers and cannon. The city received a grant from NOPEC to help defer the costs. They may use state purchasing power to get a better price.

**Mayor Robert Stefanik** – The city is purchasing new banners that say NR Bicentennial. They are going to ask for sponsors, such as YMCA and schools. The sponsor name will be on the bottom third of banner.

**Larry Antoskiewicz** - The city is planning the bicentennial. There will be a two-week celebration. It will include a pet carnival, bicentennial ball, fishing derby, sidewalk sale and picnic in the park. They are trying to make the picnic free to residents. They are also looking to add other events as planning continues.

## NORTH ROYALTON RECOGNIZED CLUBS:

**Baseball (NRBB): Craig Barbeck** – NRBB is considering adding cameras around York field. They are doing the Dicks community program again. Dicks day is April 14th

and 15th. Serpentini Chevrolet is also sponsoring the Test Drive program this year. NRBB is advertising around the city for registration. They are having a scavenger hunt with the location of ad signs. They also are accepting credit cards via SQUARE for fee payment. Mr. Barbeck says that the light motion sensor timer needs increased in woman's bathroom. It is turning off too soon. They are again sponsoring a scholarship for graduating NR Senior. Opening Day will be on May 25<sup>th</sup>.

**Soccer (NRSC): Vincent Weimer** - Saint Sava wants to use Heasley field for their Memorial Day tournament. Mr. Swim said it is not a problem as long as there are no schedule conflicts with NRSC. NRSC reminded Mr. Swim that the High School will lose the soccer practice field due to school construction projects this year.

**Basketball: Tom Grassi** - Basketball has submitted checks and bylaws to the City. They had 105 players this year. They had several teams in the end of year tournaments. The girls team program worked well this year.

**North Royalton Community Garden (NRCG): Dejana Cinquepalmi** - NRCG will be replacing the boards on 15 plots with money from Cargill. They have an Eagle scout that wants to expand garden toward state road by 25x75. The area will need to be leveled. Garden clean-up will be on April 7<sup>th</sup>.
