REPORTS

Recreation Department

Paul Marnecheck – Mr. Marnecheck stated that they are applying for a grant for more energy efficient lighting for ball fields.

NORTH ROYALTON RECOGNIZED CLUBS:

Baseball (NRBB): Craig Barbeck – Registration has closed and sign up is down 7-10%. They are still taking kids for Rookies. A total of 65 teams this year. The internal audit should be completed by the end of April. NRBB will be using RUA for 10U and under girls travel and internal rec teams. They are using Suburban for Boys 11U and older travel.

Soccer (NRSC): Vince Weimer - Fields have been wet the past two weeks, but are in good condition. All travel teams are in Medina MIST tournament. Picture day is set for 2nd weekend in May.

Basketball (NRBA): Tom Grassi - Season has ended but some teams are still playing in AAU tournaments.

North Royalton Community Garden (NRCG): Dejana Cinquepalmi - 15 new plots using funds from Cargill have been added giving the gardens a total of 41 lots. Eight

High School students helped get the plots ready. No planting has started yet. Garden tours will be open during city wide picnic. Andrew Vancer received his eagle scout award. He built the compost bin and planting table for his project.

Football (NRYF): Mike Kinney - Mr. Kinney is the new football commissioner. Mr. Kinney asked about using Valley Vista for practices. Mr. Swim told him to send in the forms to city and schools. NRYF registration will open mid-April.

YMCA: Kevin Demming - Sign-ups for weekly summer camps are going on now. 1st half of spring basketball is complete. Men's softball is full (14 teams total). Registration for t-ball is still open

Mayor Stefanik - Bicentennial celebration starts July 28th. Home days August 10-12. Bids for Pavilion on the greens will go out for new bids in September. They only got 1 bid when they put it out the first time. The contractors felt the timeframe for construction was too tight.

ADJOURNMENT



