Asphalt Surfaces with multiple cracks and uneven areas






Multiple fence repairs and gate repairs were also needed





17,535.00 Of fence repairs were done including new bottom and mid rails and repair and restting of all the gates.





The asphalt surface was then prepped, filled and leveled in preparation for a new topcoat

The entire project was completed, and the courts re-opened to the public on June 16, 2018. \$17,535 of fencing repairs were done. \$42,475 was spent on the leveling and re-surfacing of the playing surface. In addition, the asphalt was replaced on the pathway to the main gate and the pathway on the East side of the courts was also redone at a cost of \$4506.00. Totla cost of the project was \$64,516. The surface is expected to last approximately 10 to 12 years depending upon usage rate, weather, etc.





Additional Notes

Head baseball coach Brad Klingbeil will be stepping down next year. His four kids are getting older now and he would like more family time. No timeline has been set at this time for choosing his successor.

Christopher Esterak has been hired as the new girls' varsity basketball coach. He has 19 years of coaching experience, 14 in girls' basketball. He has a history of performance which shows program improvements over a short period of time. He comes to us from Woodridge High School where he led them to their first league title in 12 years. He is a physical education teacher in a neighboring district and displays an understanding of the importance of solid academics for his athletes.
