## APPROVAL OF MINUTES

## REPORTS

**Recreation Department: Jason Swim –** The Recreation Department aerated all fields and put down 450lbs seed along with 144 tons of sand at Heasley. The Heasley pavilion roof was replaced and they installed new gutters. They also completed the fence work at Heasley. York fields were aerated and seeded. York 2 and 8 were groomed; there is no longer grass in the infield. They are looking into what fence work needs to be done on York 4 and 5.

**School Board: Dr. John Kelly –** Memorial and Albion fields have been prepped and ready to go in the Spring. Construction update: The middle school HVAC and roof are done. Looking for a guaranteed maximum price for middle school security entrance. The high school major updates will be started Spring 2019. The new elementary school is still waiting for approval from EPA. *See attached Fall Sports Report.*

**Council: Paul Marnecheck –** The City has been awarded a grant for sidewalks on State Rd. from Memorial Park to Akins and Akins to Valley Parkway. The Valley Parkway trail is now open. The city is getting a new LED sign to replace the current sign on the city green. The City Green existing lighting will not be affected. The wastewater treatment plant's 5-year permit is being renewed. The Royalton road widening will begin with the waterline and sewer work. Only one lane will be closed at a time during the project.





## Marching Band
