REPORTS

Recreation Department: Jason Swim – New doors have been ordered for the baseball equipment room. The existing doors are very rusted. They are planning on 4 truckloads (96 tons) of diamond pro this year. They have ordered more sand and fertilizer for fields as well.

School Board: Dr. John Kelly – Not Present – No Report

Council: Paul Marnecheck – The city saved \$107K 2017 and \$118K 2018 by switching to Rumke for recycling and trash collection. AARP will be offering tax preparation assistance this year. April 20th and Sept 20th 9am-noon are city the shredding days for 2019.

North Royalton Community Garden (NRCG): Dejana Cinquepalmi - Not Present, but Mr. Wells read the following email report from Dejana: NRCG is full for the 2019 gardening season. They are still in search of Boy Scout or other groups willing to help with garden expansion already approved by the city. They are still accepting names for their waiting list for future gardeners. The first meeting of the season for all garden members will be held on Feb 19; forms and fees will be collected at that time. The gardening season is scheduled to open April 1 (weather permitting). They are evaluating the garden for replacements of plot boards. Last year they replaced 15 plots with new boards.
