## REPORTS

**Recreation Department: Jason Swim** – Not much happening waiting for Spring

**School Board: Dr. John Kelly** – The State of Schools address is tonight, Dr. Kelly invited everyone. There will also be a construction update at the meeting. See Dr. Kelly's Winter sports update report below after the minutes.

**Council: Paul Marnecheck** – The new City Green sign is on order. It should be installed before Home Days. They city received a \$100k grant to pay for the update. During 2018 there were 144 deer culled and 220 deer collected by animal control. Deer damage from car crashes is down 50%. They City was awarded Excellence in Financial Accounting by the state auditor.

**Baseball (NRBB): Craig Barbeck** – Summer registration is under way and the sponsorship drive is ongoing. NRBB partnered with Dicks and Chevrolet for their youth programs. **Soccer (NRSC): Vince Weimer** – NRSC purchased Team Snap for the travel program with funds raised from a recent fundraiser. They moved their cash surplus to money market accounts to earn interest. NRSC is looking at future projects for the surplus funds. The Spring registration is opened. The trustee meeting is on March 12<sup>th</sup> @ 7pm at city hall.

**Basketball (BANR): Mike Lee** – BANR finished the championships for all ages. They had 2 championship teams. 2 players selected for all-star team. March 20<sup>th</sup> is Cavs

day at the Q, kids will sing the national anthem. Surveys going out to all parents at the end of the month to seek feedback. They will be giving check to City for the \$5 participation fee soon.

**North Royalton Community Garden (NRCG): Dejana Cinquepalmi** – There are 76 gardeners this year. They have a scheduled work day on 4/13 and plan to open on 4/27. They received a donation for a broad fork (\$300). They are still looking for a Boy Scout to expand the garden.





