APPROVAL OF MINUTES

REPORTS

Recreation Department: Jason Swim – Not Present (Mr. Marnecheck read emailed report) - They are currently working with soccer and baseball making adjustments to get in as many games as possible. It has been a very wet spring and has been hard on all organizations. Mr. Swim will be attending a planning meeting with both Soccer and Baseball to discuss work and improvements on the soccer and baseball fields soon. They want to get on the Heasley fields to start spot repairs and work on the drainage issues on Field #1 and #2 at the end of May. They will work with the soccer club and the church to schedule around and camps throughout the summer. They plan spread Diamond Pro and Ball field conditioner on all York fields at the end of May or beginning of June, weather permitting. They are going heavy this year and plan to spread 96 Tons of Diamond Pro.

School Board: Dr. John Kelly – See attached summary.

Council: Paul Marnecheck – The city has allocated \$1.4 million for larger infrastructure repairs on several roads and developments. There were 2060 lbs. of paper shredded at the community shred day. The next shred day is September 21, 2019 from 9am-noon. The NR Office on Aging is having a trip to Prescott isles on Monday, June 10th. The Cemetery entrance work is under way. The city green is getting new conduit – the project will be done in time for summer activities. The Drug take back was this past weekend. They have reached 1-ton cumulative drugs, since they started the program about 5 years ago. There is a secure location at the police station 24/7 to drop any drugs anonymously.
