REPORTS

Recreation Department: Jason Swim – Mr. Swim will be meeting with NRSC and NRBB this summer about the fields along with their short term and long-term needs. They will also be discussing fencing and other minor repairs. They may even be able to do bigger projects next year.

School Board: Dr. John Kelly – Softball lost in 3rd round of tournament. Baseball lost in the 7th inning of district final 3-2. Track – boys 4x400 relay team set a new school record regionals. The Bears Baseball camp is June-17-19. Graduation is this Friday. There will be a lot of construction as the HS and Middle school over the summer.

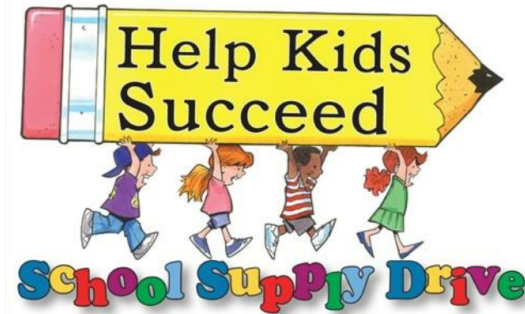
