REPORTS

Recreation Department: Jason Swim – Not much going on. Cybersecurity insurance is recommended for each organization, but not required. It will probably be required in the new rules for the groups next year. Mr. Swim asked the YMCA about t-ball and soccer schedules, so they do not to overlap times for those kids that want to do both.

School Board: Dr. John Kelly – The construction projects (High School and new Elementary school) are on time and on budget. The Schools got a more favorable rate on stadium cops project and saved 600K.

Council: Paul Marnecheck – This Sunday is the Christmas parade. It starts at 4:45pm. The paving and waterline projects are wrapping up for the season. Wreaths Across America will be putting wreaths at the cemetery this season.



ADJOURNMENT


