## CLARIFYING AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 898 AND 970

## AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO A NORTH VERNON UTILITY SERVICE BOARD AMENDED RESOLUTION FOR A CLARIFICATION OF WASTEWATER RATES AND THE CREATION OF ADDITIONAL MINIMUM WASTEWATER RATES OF THE NORTH VERNON MUNICIPAL UTILITES FOR 2018, 2019, 2020

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the North Vernon Utility Service Board and of the North Vernon Common Council to ensure that rates and charges made by the City for services be nondiscriminatory, reasonable, and just;

WHEREAS, for the rates and charges for services to be reasonable and just, the rates and charges must be adequate to produce sufficient revenue for maintenance costs, operating charges, depreciation, and interest charges on bonds;

WHEREAS, the rates and charges are currently providing the minimum coverage required for the existing debt under certain assumptions and need to continue providing the minimum coverage;

WHEREAS, the Utility Service Board, recognizing the need to maintain the minimum debt service coverage and the need to provide reasonable funds to operate and maintain the wastewater utility has passed a resolution, attached hereto, maintaining the annual increases over the next three years;

WHEREAS, the Utility Service Board recognizes the need to further clarify the previously passed and attached resolutions maintaining the annual increases over the next three years; and

WHEREAS, the Utility Service Board, recognizes that users with meters larger than  $5/8 - \frac{3}{4}$  inch that are using a minimum amount of water are not currently paying a minimum rate that is representative of the system capacity set aside for those minimum users, and that those customers should be paying such a minimum rate.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City of North Vernon that the North Vernon wastewater rates be clarified and increased for the additional minimum user rates as follows:
