BOROUGH OF NORWOOD END-OF-YEAR ENGINEER'S REPORT DECEMBER 2022

1. Blanche Avenue Bridge Improvements



Neglia assisted the Borough in obtaining a grant from the New Jersey Department of Transportation Municipal Aid program in the amount of \$224,000 towards the construction of the bridge improvements. Neglia provided construction management/inspection services for the project. A contract was awarded in the amount of \$619,311.25 and was completed in the Spring of this year. Neglia is currently working with NJDOT to obtain final grant reimbursement.

2. Knickerbocker Baseball Field and Kennedy Field Dugouts

Neglia provided professional surveying, engineering, and bidding services for the Knickerbocker Baseball Field Improvements which included new dugouts, sod, infield clay, fencing, irrigation, and stormwater management measures. A contract was awarded in the amount of \$285,980.00 and construction was completed early this summer.

Neglia assisted the Borough in soliciting quotes and ultimately purchasing six (6) new dugouts in the amount of \$51,665.00. Installation of dugouts including new fencing, gates, and concrete pads were completed this spring.

3. Norwood Dog Park

Neglia assisted the Borough in obtaining a grant in the amount of \$98,480 from the Bergen County Open Space program, and provided professional surveying, engineering design, bidding, and construction management/inspection services for this project. Additionally, Neglia aided the Borough in obtaining NJDEP Land Use Permit necessary for construction. A contract was awarded in the amount of \$122,125.00 with construction of the dog park being substantially completed this fall. Finished touches and improvements near the Swim Club are anticipated to be completed in Spring 2023.

4. 2022 Municipal Road Program

a. Walnut Street Improvements (NJDOT MA-22 Funded)

Neglia assisted the Borough in obtaining a grant from the New Jersey Department of Transportation Municipal Aid program in the amount of \$221,000 towards the paving of Walnut Street. Neglia provided professional engineering design and bidding services and is currently providing construction management/inspection services. A contract was awarded in the amount of \$172,502.18 and concrete curb repair started and finished in November. Milling and paving is expected to be completed in Spring 2023.

b. 2022 Municipal Road Program (Municipal Funded)

Neglia provided professional surveying, engineering design and bidding services for this project and is in the process of assisting the Borough in obtaining NJDEP Land Use Permits for the construction of a

sidewalk along Hemlock Court. A contract was awarded in the amount of \$757,479.18 and includes paving of Hemlock Court and the Fire Company Parking Lot. Milling and paving is expected to be completed in Spring 2023.

c. Summit Street Drainage

i. Neglia has prepared construction documents and estimated quantities for the installation of two (2) new catch basins and stormwater piping within Summit Street. The construction plan and quantities have been submitted to Smith-Sondy for pricing. Upon receipt, Neglia will prepare a change order and provide it to the Mayor and Council for approval for this work to be added to the 2022 Municipal Road Program.

5. Livingston Street Crosswalk

Neglia has submitted a site plan for the construction of crosswalk and ADA Accessible curb ramps across Livingston Street near the Dunkin Donuts to Bergen County for review. Initial comments have been received and Neglia is currently working with the County to address them.

6. Kennedy Field Playground

Neglia has participated in meetings with the playground subcommittee. The subcommittee has received layouts for playground equipment, which Neglia has used to prepare a preliminary cost estimate. Final engineering design will begin upon approval of a playground layout by the governing body.

7. Kennedy Field Basketball Court

Neglia was made aware of surficial cracking observed at the recently constructed basketball court. Our office, on behalf of the Borough, coordinated with the contractor to have the basketball surface repaired and resurfaced, at no cost to the Borough, in Spring 2023.

RESOLUTION # 2023-07

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A CASH MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Borough of Norwood to earn additional revenue through the investment and prudent management of its cash receipts; and

WHEREAS, P.L. 1983, Chapter 8 approved January 18, 1983 is an act concerning the Local Fiscal Affairs Law and amends N.J.S.A. 40A:5-2 and N.J.S.A. 40A:5-15; and

WHEREAS, this law requires that each local unit shall adopt a cash management plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following shall constitute the Cash Management Plan for the Borough of Norwood and the Borough of Norwood shall deposit and manage its funds pursuant to this plan:

Definitions:

- 1. Treasurer shall mean the Treasurer of the Borough of Norwood.
- 2. Fiscal year shall mean the twelve-month period ending December Thirty One.
- 3. Cash Management Plan shall mean that plan as approved by resolution.

Designation of Depositories:

1. At least once each fiscal year the governing body shall by resolution designate the depositories for the Borough of Norwood in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:5-4.

Authority to Invest:

1. The governing body shall pass a resolution at a first meeting of the fiscal year designating the Borough official(s) who shall make and be responsible for municipal deposits and investments.

Investment Instruments:

1. The Treasurer shall invest at her discretion any investment instruments as approved by the State of New Jersey, Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services and in accordance with N.J.S.A.40A:5-15.1.

Records and Reports:

- 1. The Treasurer shall report all investments in accordance with N.J.S.A.40A:5-15.2.
- 2. At a minimum the Treasurer shall:
 - a. Keep a record of all investments.
 - b. Keep cash position record, which reveals, on a daily basis, the status of the Borough's cash in its bank accounts.
 - c. Report monthly to the governing body as to the status of cash balances in the bank accounts, interest rates and interest earned.

Cash Flow:
