PAYMENTS IN ADDITION TO SPECIFIC DOLLAR AMOUNT

The obligor shall pay directly to the State Disbursement Unit or other agency the amount of _____ from the following other sources of income lump sum, net bonus, retirement withdraw distributed to obligor from payor, other this amount is not subject to withholding by employer until further order of court and the percentage is based upon _____ minor child(ren).

DELINQUENCY

If the obligor becomes delinquent in the payment of support after the entry of this Order for Support, the obligor must pay, in addition to the current support obligation, the sum of (a) \$ _____ for child support per the payment frequency ordered above for child support, and (b) \$ _____ for maintenance or unallocated support per the payment frequency ordered above for maintenance or unallocated support, until the delinquency is paid in full. A support obligation, or any portion of a support obligation which becomes due and remains unpaid for 30 days or more shall accrue interest at the rate of 9% per annum.

PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

A notice to withhold income shall issue immediately and shall be served on the employer or payor of income as defined in the Income Withholding Act of obligor. Payments shall be made payable to the State Disbursement Unit and sent to the State Disbursement Unit at P.O. Box 5400, Carol Stream, IL 60197-5400. Payments must include CASE NUMBER, COUNTY of the Court issuing this Order, and obligor's name and social security number.

The parties have entered into a written agreement providing for an alternative arrangement for the payment of support that is approved by the Court and attached to this Order, meeting all requirements of, and consistent with, applicable law. An income withholding notice is to be prepared and served only if the obligor becomes delinquent in paying the order for support. Payments shall be made in accordance with the written agreement of the parties attached hereto. In the event the income withholding notice is served upon and payor, payments must be withheld and sent to the State Disbursement Unit as set forth above.

INSURANCE

The obligor, or obligee, or obligor and obligee, shall provide health insurance for the child(ren) either by enrolling them in any health insurance coverage available through the obligor's, or obligee's, or obligor's and obligee's, employment or securing a private health insurance policy, accepted by the obligor and obligee or approved by the Court, which names the child(ren) as beneficiary. Both the obligor and the obligee shall be provided a copy of the insurance policy and the insurance card.

COLLECTION FEE

In addition to and separate from amounts ordered to be paid as maintenance or child support, the obligor shall pay a \$36.00 per year Separate Maintenance and Child Support Collection Fee. This sum shall be paid directly to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Ogle County at the Civil Division, 106 S. 5th St., Suite 300, Oregon, Illinois 61061. This fee is not sent to the Illinois State Disbursement Unit.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

The obligor shall give written notice to the Clerk of the Court, and if a party is receiving child and spouse services under Article X of the Illinois Public Aid Code, to the Department of Public Aid, within 7 days, of:

- any new residential, mailing address, or
- the name, address and phone number of any new employer, and;
- any change in access to health insurance coverage through the employer or other group coverage and if so provide the policy name and identifying number(s) of health insurance coverage available.

The obligor shall submit a written report of termination of employment and of new employment, including name and address of the new employer, to the Clerk of the Court and obligee within 10 days. Obligor and obligee shall advise each other of a change of residence within 5 days except when the Court finds that the physical, mental or emotional health of a party or that of a minor child, or both, would be seriously endangered by disclosure of the party's address. 750 ILCS 5/505(h). An obligee receiving payments through income withholding shall notify the Clerk of the Court and State Disbursement Unit within 7 days, of a change in residence.

If there is an unpaid arrearage or delinquency (as those terms are defined in the Income Withholding for Support Act) equal to at least one month's support obligation on the termination date stated in the order for support or, if there is no termination date stated in the order, on the date the child attains the age of majority or prior to that date shall automatically continue to be an obligation, not as current support but as periodic to any periodic payment previously required for satisfaction of the arrearage or delinquency. The total periodic amount to be paid toward satisfaction of the arrearage or delinquency may be enforced and collected by a method provided by law for enforcement and collection of child support, including but not limited to income withholding under the Income Withholding for Support Act. 750 ILCS 5/505(g-5).
