ARREST MADE IN FEBRUARY 10, 2019 STABBING INVESTIGATION IN AREA OF NORTH 11th STREET PROSPECT PARK, NJ

PROSPECT PARK, NEW JERSEY:

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes Prospect Park Police Chief Charlie Atie, and Hawthorne Police Chief Richard McAuliffe announce that Omroy O. Williams, 34 years of Prospect Park, NJ was arrested February 10, 2019 in relation to a stabbing investigation that took the same date. Mr. Williams is charged with Attempted Murder, First Degree; Aggravated Assault, Second Degree; Aggravated Assault, Third Degree; Unlawful Possession of a Weapon (knife), Fourth Degree; and Possession of a Weapon (knife) for an Unlawful Purpose, Third Degree.

On February 10, 2019 at approximately 8:49 p.m. members of the Hawthorne Police Department responded to the area of Lafayette Avenue on a report of a male bleeding. Upon arrival the police located a 26-year-old male Saddle Brook resident who had sustained multiple stab wounds. The victim was immediately transported to St. Joseph's Medical Center in Paterson for treatment. Based on the initial investigation the victim was in the area of North 11th Street Prospect Park, NJ when stabbed.

The sentencing exposure for Mr. Williams on First Degree Attempted Murder is 10-20 years New Jersey State Prison with 85% of the term to be served before parole pursuant to the No Early Release Act and 5 years parole supervision; on Second Degree Aggravated Assault it is 5-10 years New Jersey State Prison with 85% of the terms to be served before parole pursuant to the No Early Release Act and 3 years parole supervision; Third Degree Aggravated Assault it is 3-5 years New Jersey State Prison; on Fourth Degree, Unlawful Possession of a Weapon it is 18 months New Jersey State Prison; and on Third Degree Possession of a Weapon for an Unlawful Purpose it is 3-5 years New Jersey State Prison
