NON-FATAL SHOOTING IN AREA OF CARROLL STREET PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

JANUARY 25, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 5:20 a.m. on January 25, 2019, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson on a report that a 45-year-old male Paterson resident was seeking treatment for a non-fatal gunshot wound. A potential crime scene has been located in the area of Carroll Street Paterson, NJ. In addition the police received a call of shots fired in the area of Carroll Street at approximately 1:40 a.m., but no victim was located.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
