SHOOTING IN AREA OF 12th AVENUE AND EAST 23rd STREET PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

FEBRUARY 6, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately, 3:25 a.m. on February 6, 2019, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of 12th Avenue and East 23rd Street on a report of shots fired. Upon arrival the police located a potential crime scene, but were unable to locate any victim(s). A short time later members of the Paterson Police Department were advised that a 29-year-old male Paterson resident and a 23-year-old male Paterson resident arrived at Saint Joseph's Medical Center in Paterson for treatment of non-fatal gunshot wounds.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
