SHOOTING IN AREA OF CLINTON AND NORTH 6th STREET PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

FEBRUARY 6, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 7:05, p.m. on February 6, 2019, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of Clinton and North 6th Street Paterson, NJ on a report of a shots fired/victim shot in the area of Clinton and North 6th Street Paterson, NJ. Upon arrival the police located 20-year-old male Paterson resident who sustained a non-fatal gunshot wound located in a business in the area of Clinton and North 6th Street. The victim was immediately transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment. Based on the initial investigation the victim was struck on the street and sought assistance in the business.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
