## SHOOTING IN AREA OF EAST MAIN STREET PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

JANUARY 22, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 4:56, p.m. on January 22, 2019, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of East Main Street Paterson, NJ on a report of shots fired. Upon arrival the police located 34-year-old male Haledon resident who sustained a non-fatal gunshot wound and a 68-year-old male Paterson resident who sustained non-fatal gunshot wounds. The victims were immediately transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
