SHOOTING IN AREA OF TEMPLE STREET PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

FEBRUARY 18, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 1:58, p.m. on February 18, 2019, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of Temple Street Paterson, NJ on a report of a shot fired. Upon arrival the police located 19-year-old female Clifton resident, in a business in the area of Temple Street, who sustained a non-fatal gunshot. The victim was immediately transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
