INFORMATION SOUGHT FROM THE PUBLIC REGARDING FATAL HIT AND RUN MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT NEAR 392 UNION AVENUE IN TOTOWA

TOTOWA, NEW JERSEY:

December 6, 2017

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Totowa Police Chief Robert Coyle announce that the vehicle sought in connection with the fatal hit and run accident on December 4, 2017, near 392 Union Boulevard in the Borough of Totowa is a small white SUV, possibly a Nissan Murano. Grace Strazza was struck and killed by the white SUV as she was crossing Union Avenue. After striking Ms. Strazza, the white SUV fled the scene before the police arrived. Surveillance video at the scene captured images of the suspect vehicle as it left the scene. Investigators request anyone with knowledge of this accident or the vehicle depicted in the surveillance video contact the authorities.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
