### **PASSAIC COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS ADMINISTER NALOXONE IN BLOOMINGDALE ON NOVEMBER 28, 2017**

BLOOMINGDALE, NEW JERSEY:

NOVEMBER 30, 2017

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Bloomingdale Police Chief Joseph Borell announce that law enforcement officers in Passaic County administered Naloxone to one subject on November 28, 2017. Naloxone is a medicine administered by way of spray into the subject's nostrils to counteract an opioid overdose.

Bloomingdale police officers deployed Naloxone at 9:04 p.m. to a 25 year old male, who resides in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Officers administered two (2) doses of Naloxone and the subject became responsive. Care of the subject was transferred to local emergency medical services.

Since 2014, members of law enforcement in Passaic County have received training in the administration of Naloxone to respond to suspected opiate overdoses. This incident is the one hundred and fifty-third (153<sup>rd</sup>) Naloxone deployment in Passaic County in 2017.
