SHOOTING IN AREA OF 291 HAMILTON AVENUE PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

October 30, 2017

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Deputy Paterson Police Chief Ibrahim Baycora announce that at approximately 12:38 a.m. on October 28, 2017, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of 291 Hamilton Avenue Paterson, NJ on a report of shots fired. When police arrived they found a possible crime scene but no victim in the area. Shortly thereafter, the police were advised that a 36-year-old male Paterson resident had responded to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment of a non-life threatening gunshot wound.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
