SHOOTING IN AREA OF 229 PARK AVENUE PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

December 2, 2017

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Deputy Paterson Police Chief Ibrahim Baycora announce that at approximately 11:57 a.m. on December 2, 2017, members of the Paterson Police Department were dispatched to 772 East 19th Street on a report of shots fired. Upon arrival they were notified that a 20-year-old male Paterson resident had arrived at Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment of a non-fatal gunshot wound. Based on the initial investigation, the victim was on the area of 229 Park Avenue when he was shot

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
