SHOOTING IN AREA OF 36 ARCH STREET PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

September 27, 2017

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Deputy Paterson Police Chief Ibrahim Baycora announce that at approximately 8:51 p.m. on September 26, 2017, police responded to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson, where a 31-year old male from Paterson, NJ sought treatment for a gunshot wound. Based on the initial investigation, the victim stated he was in a vehicle traveling in the area Arch Street, Paterson, NJ when a bullet came through the passenger side door striking him. In addition, there had been a report of shots fired in the area of Arch Street at approximately the same time and a possible crime scene was discovered in the area of 36 Arch Street.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
