SHOOTING IN AREA OF MAIN STREET AND BROADWAY PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

November 23, 2017

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Deputy Paterson Police Chief Ibrahim Baycora announce that at approximately 8:45 p.m. on November 22, 2017, members of the Paterson Police Department discovered a 43-year old male Clifton resident, who sustained a non-fatal gunshot wound in the area of Main Street and Broadway Paterson, NJ. The victim was immediately transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment. Based on the initial investigation, the victim was operating a small private bus when he was shot during the course of an alleged robbery.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
