HOMICIDE VICTIM DISCOVERED NEAR 192 GODWIN AVENUE

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

November 8, 2017

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Deputy Paterson Police Chief Ibrahim Baycora announce that at approximately 9:40, p.m. on November 6, 2017, police responded to the area of 192 Godwin Avenue in the city of Paterson in response to a report of shots fired. Upon arrival they located a 28 year-old male victim from Paterson, Ramon Mosquea, outside the residence with what appeared to be multiple gunshot wounds. The victim was transported to St. Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson where he succumbed to his wounds and was pronounced deceased at 10:10 p.m.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
