MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT AT THE INTERSECTION OF TERHUNE DRIVE AND HAMBURG TURNPIKE IN WAYNE

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

October 5, 2017

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Wayne Police Chief James Clarke announce that at approximately 1:35 p.m., on October 4, 2017, police responded to the intersection of Terhune Drive and Hamburg Turnpike in the Township of Wayne in response to a two vehicle collision. A 1999 Toyota Corolla driven by an 83-year-old Wanaque man was involved in a collision with a 2012 Honda Odyssey driven by a 47-year-old man from Butler. The driver of the Toyota suffered serious injuries. The driver of the Honda did not suffer any injuries, but two passengers in the Honda did suffer minor injuries. All of the injured parties were transported to St. Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
