## SHOOTING IN AREA OF 420 10<sup>th</sup> AVENUE, PATERSON NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

January 5, 2018

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Deputy Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 12:37 p.m. on January 5, 2018, members of the Paterson Police Department were dispatched to the area of 429 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue Paterson, NJ on a report of shooting/shots fired. Upon arrival they located a 25-year-old male Paterson resident who had sustained a non-fatal gunshot wound. The victim was immediately transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
