## SHOOTING IN AREA OF CARROLL STREET PATERSON NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

February 22, 2018

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Acting Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 4:16, p.m. on February 22, 2018, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of Carroll Street Paterson, NJ on a report of shots fired. Upon arrival the police located a possible crime scene, but were unable to locate a victim. A short time later, the police were notified that a 26-year-old male Paterson resident had arrived at Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment of multiple non-fatal gunshot wounds.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
