SHOOTING IN AREA OF MAIN AND WEISS STREET PATERSON NJ

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 9:56, p.m. on April 23, 2018, members of the Paterson Police Department police responded to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson, where a 22-year old male from Paterson, NJ was seeking treatment for a non-fatal gunshot wound.

Based on the initial investigation, the victim was near the intersection of Main and Weiss Street Paterson, NJ when the shooting took place.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
