SHOOTING IN AREA OF MAIN AND WEISS STREET PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

APRIL 25, 2018

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 7:05, p.m. on April 24, 2018, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of Main and Weiss Street Paterson, NJ on a report of shots fired. Upon arrival the police located a possible crime scene, but were unable to locate a victim. A short time later, the police were notified that a 21-year-old male Jersey City resident had arrived at Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment of non-fatal gunshot wounds.

Based on the initial investigation, the victim was in the area of Main and Weiss Street Paterson, NJ when the shooting took place.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
