FATAL MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT INVOLVING A PATERSON POLICE OFFICER ON GETTY AVENUE IN PATERSON

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

April 22, 2018

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 10:50 a.m., on Sunday April 22, 2018, police responded to the area of 150 Getty Avenue in the City of Paterson in response to a motor vehicle collision. Upon their arrival they discovered that an on-duty Paterson Police Officer operating a marked patrol unit was involved in a collision with a parked vehicle. The officer was the only person involved in the crash and was transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center, where he later died from his injuries. No other parties were injured as a result of this crash.

The cause of the crash remains under investigation. More information will be released once it becomes available.
