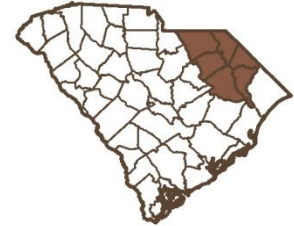

## **Transportation Action Committee (TAC)**

### Meeting

September 15, 2022, 10:30 am  
2314 Pisgah Road, Florence, SC

- I. Welcome - Sammie Copeland
  - TAC Chair called the meeting to order at 10:00 am and all attendees introduced themselves
- II. Pee Dee Regional Project Updates - Brian Dix (or representative)
  - Brian Dix provided updates on projects in the region. No significant problems are being encountered. He provided written overview of the projects as well. Many of the projects are in the Engineering stage or nearing completion.
- III. Construction Project Updates
  - a. SCDOT District 4 – Chesterfield County - Greg Williams (or representative)
  - b. SCDOT District 5 – Darlington, Dillon, Florence, Marion & Marlboro Counties - Kyle Berry (or representative)
    - Joey Skipper provided the District 5 update. Many resurfacing projects are underway throughout the district. Joey states that there are a couple of material issues that are affecting the flow of work, but for the most part everything is progressing smoothly.
- IV. Pee Dee COG Staff Update
  - a. Potential Tap Project
    - Lindsay Privette briefly discussed TAP and the type of projects that the program can be used for. There are currently no projects on the radar, but the TAC Chair should be aware that funds are available and should be on the lookout for potential projects.
  - b. Dillon County – SC 9/57 and S-76 Intersection Improvement
    - Lindsay Privette explained that is a major sewer line problem that lies underneath the intersection. She explained that this is essentially a sewer line project with a roadway project on top of it, and that CDBG or other grants would be able to help pay for this portion of the project. Brian Dix stated that the PDCOG should decide whether to move forward with additional funding, remove, or delay funding until further action is taken. TAC chair decided to delay the funding until further action is taken.

c. 2022 Freight Plan General Public Survey

- Dunae Shaw Presented the SCDOT 2022 Freight Plan General Public Survey. Dunae explained the survey is used to tell SCDOT about the freight transportation trends and issues that impact our community the most and provide feedback on long-term priorities, vision and goals. David Gray stated that the survey will be available for the public until October 10, 2022 and encourages everyone to participate and get as many people as possible to submit feedback. Carolyn Prince asked David Gray to inform the Marlboro County Economic Development of this survey, so that the industries of Marlboro County would also be informed. Dunae Shaw will email the link to the TAC.

V. Comments & Questions

- Brief discussion about some of the bridges on SC Highway 9 from Leon Johnson. He stated that some of the bridges were in bad condition and would like to know what can be done to remedy the problems. Sammie Copeland stated that there are now Load Restrictions on some of the bridges to prevent overloading and 1 bridge had been made 1 lane only. Lindsay Privette stated that seeking additional sources of funding would be the best idea, but the problem could still be years out, due to problems such as material shortages, acquiring the funds, and detours that would be necessary.
- Leon Johnson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Marshall Munn seconded the motion.
