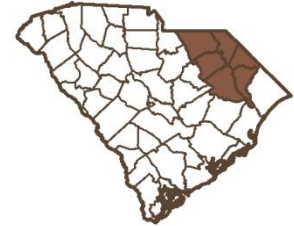

Transportation Action Committee (TAC)

Meeting

June 14, 2022, 10:00 am

- I. Welcome - Sammie Copeland
 - TAC Chair called the meeting to order at 10:00 am and all attendees introduced themselves.

- II. Pee Dee Regional Project Updates - Brian Dix (or representative)
 - Brian Dix provided updates on projects in the region. No significant problems are being encountered. He provided written overview of the projects as well. All of the feasibility studies that had been programmed into the TIP were added to the STIP during the SCDOT Commission in May 2022.

- III. Construction Project Updates
 - a. SCDOT District 4 – Chesterfield County - Greg Williams (or representative)

 - b. SCDOT District 5 – Darlington, Dillon, Florence, Marion & Marlboro Counties - Kyle Berry (or representative)
 - Joey Skipper provided the District 5 update. Many resurfacing projects are underway throughout the district

- IV. Action Items
 - a. Public Participation Plan Draft Review and Acceptance
 - Chairman asked for action on the Public Participation Plan. Marshall Munn made a motion to accept, Leon Johnson seconded the motion. There was no discussion. Acceptance of the plan was unanimous.
 - b. Rural Planning Work Program Review and Acceptance
 - Chairman asked Lindsay Privette to explain the RPWP. She did so, and Marshall Munn made a motion to accept the RPWP. Leon Johnson seconded the motion. There was no discussion. Acceptance of the plan was unanimous.
 - c. SC 378 Feasibility Study
 - Chairman discussed the US 378 study and asked Lindsay Privette to provide an update and overview of it. Privette explained that PDRCOG has asked WRCOG for formal approval to study inside the WRCOG region. Marshall Munn made a motion to place the US 378 Study

on the PDCOG TIP pending PDCOG receiving a written agreement from WRCOG for PDRCOG to extend the study into the WRCOG region.

d. Cypress Street, Mullins – Adding to PDCOG TIP

- Chairman asked Lindsay Privette to describe the Cypress Street project. Privette explained that it is connected to an economic development project at Sopakco in Mullins. The company has made a series of expansions that have led to increased truck traffic and a need to improve Cypress Street. Funding has been an issue. Right of way is going to be a problem. Privette wanted to bring the area to the attention of the TAC as a way of exploring all options for funding. Leon Johnson made a motion to table the Cypress Street project until Lindsay Privette is able to gather more information, working with Brian Dix and possibly the Marion County CTC. Marshall Munn seconded the motion. Acceptance of the motion was unanimous.

- Leon Johnson asked about adding Highway 52 to Darlington/Highway 52 Bypass to a study because there is significant perception of danger in the intersection. Brian Dix suggested that a feasibility study. Privette stated that the interchange had been studied and safety numbers do not show it being a problem, but that there is a perception of danger. Joey Skipper said that they can work with Maintenance and repaint the lines.
- Leon Johnson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Marshall Munn seconded the motion.
