Pat was drafted in 1941 (18 years old) at the time he was working at a Seattle ship yard. But Because of his welding skills he was deferred until 1943. His first ship was the LST 1028 it was torpedoed by a suicide boat at the Battle of Lingayen Gulf. The LST was towed back to Seattle were Pat was reassigned to a small boat crew on the USS Nevada in 1944. The Nevada was doing "MAGIC" "Carpet Runs" between San Diego and Pearl harbor Hawaii he was discharged from the USS Nevada in 1945.
