

Rules of the Road

No smoking allowed on the van

No open alcoholic beverages of any kind allowed on van

Any intoxicated passengers will not be permitted to ride

No profanity or belligerent talking allowed

No sheath knives or folding knives of 3" or more on the van no firearms permitted

Infant carriers are required for infant children and are to be provided by parents or guardian

Riders will remain seated with safety belt on when the van is moving

All merchandise and walkers or canes must be secured under the seat or in specified areas and stored in approved container of dimensions not to exceed 15 inches wide by 24 inches tall

Space available for purchases will be dependent on number of passengers traveling on any given trip.

Notifying the Public of Rights Under Title VI

NEVADA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NDOT)

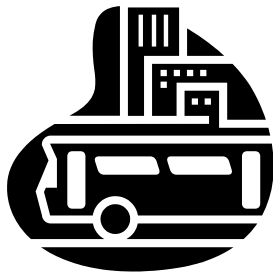


The Van travels to Fallon and Reno monthly please schedule your out of town appointments on the dates listed in the Newsletter.
