Pershing County, Nevada, is requesting Statements of Qualifications (“SOQ”) for Professional Consulting Services necessary to design and manage projects for the Imlay Public Water System. Consulting Firms and or teams (Consultant) shall have extensive, recent, and direct experience in all phases of the projects proposed for the including the following: public water system engineering design including wells and tanks, applications for public funding of capital improvements for public works projects, permitting of water systems in the State of Nevada, and project management relating to the improvements and funding process.

Respondents shall prepare a Statement of Qualifications as described below. Each responding Consultant shall provide detailed evidence of its competency, capability, and expertise to complete the Scope of Services. Pershing County desires succinct submittals that address the specific content requirements. To facilitate the review of all submittals, each SOQ shall be printed on 8-1/2” x 11” sheet size; Typewritten with no smaller than 10-point font size; No more than twenty single-sided sheets excluding front/back covers, cover letter, and dividers; Economically produced, and Three (3) copies of the SOQ shall be addressed to:
