

## PIKE COUNTY ROAD TASK FORCE MINUTES

August 17, 2023

1. **CALL TO ORDER:** 2:00 pm
2. **ROLL CALL:** Keith Raser, Brian Snyder, Keith Rodriguez, Rich Bailo, John Knapp, Ellen Enslin, Jeff Luongo, Tim Rohner, Guy Cook, Jill Gamboni, Daniel Yelito, Charles DeFebo, Ken Coutts and Cathern Danials.
3. **PUBLIC COMMENT**— None
4. **APPROVAL of MINUTES-** Motion to approve June 15, 2023, minutes made by Tim Rohner. Seconded by Guy Cook. All in Favor. Motion Passed.
5. **CORRESPONDENCE** – None
6. **PennDOT UPDATES** – See attached – Keith Rodriguez mentioned there are 8-10 holes in the SR 1013 Paving Project that was recently completed. Keith Raser confirmed this issue and said they are on the edge of the travel lane on the downhill side of the road. Charles DeFebo stated he will have a crew investigate the issue and talk with the contractor. Guy Cook asked if stop bars at the 6/434 intersection will be repainted. Rich Bailo stated he talked with the contractor for the SR 2001 bridge over Dingmans Creek and the estimated completion date has been pushed back till winter. Charles stated that there was an issue with the initial demo plan for the bridge due to the condition of the existing structure. Charels also stated that the County Seal Coat Program is ongoing. Ken Coutts mentioned that wide loads are getting stuck on SR 390. Keith Raser mentioned that there is a speeding issue at the Twin Lakes Road/Bee Hollow Road intersection. Tim Rohner stated that oil is bleeding through on SR 2001 that needs to be taken care of.
7. **COUNTY/MUNICIPAL UPDATES** – Ellen Enslin stated that the conservation District has funding available for Dirt & Gravel Road projects. Also on September 26 there will be a bus tour of recent dirt road projects in the region.

  - a. SR 2001 Grant Application – Brian Snyder stated that the NEPA MPO applied for a \$350k grant to conduct a feasibility study of the SR 2001 Section 405 Construction project.
